Everyone likes to see what others are doing and *Automata Magazine* is pleased to feature a photo gallery of readers' work in each issue. Below are some basic guidelines for sending pictures of your automata.

- Send up to three different shots of each piece (including the works, if possible)
- Include a good description of the action
- The title of the piece
- Any text written on the piece itself
- The photographer's name (if it's not you)
- If you have an online video of the piece in action, include the URL so we can link it

High-resolution photos are best. We can always make them smaller but we can't make them bigger. JPEG, TIFF, or RAW files are preferred. The subject should be well lit and in focus. Every photo should have a caption. Good photos taken with your phone are perfectly acceptable. We'll probably only run one automaton per artist per issue.

Things to send with each submission

- Your complete postal address and e-mail address (for our records only—will not be published unless you request it)
- A photo of yourself that we can run small (with your city and country) with your automaton pix. It's nice to know who the builder is
- Your website URL, if you have one
